NMI Democrats Celebrate the November 4 Blue Wave

NMI Democrats join Democrats across the United States in celebrating the Blue Wave of Democratic election victories that occurred on November 4, 2025. In a resounding repudiation of President Trump and Republican failures, voters elected Democrats up and down the ballot in numerous city, county, and statewide offices across the country.

New Jersey voters elected Congresswoman Mikie Sherrill to serve as their next governor. Sherrill is the second woman to serve in that role. Meanwhile, Virginia voters elected former Congresswoman Abigail Spanberger to serve as their governor, the first woman elected to that office. Also in Virginia, state senator Ghazala Hashmi becomes that state's lieutenant governor and the first Muslim woman elected to a statewide office in U.S. history. In California, voters said "yes" to Proposition 50, which will allow California legislators to redistrict before the midterm elections, a move, in part, to counter Republican gerrymandering occurring in other states.

In what might have been the most closely watched race this season, New York state assemblyman Zohran Mamdani emerged victorious as the next mayor of New York City. Mayor-Elect Mamdani's election night victory speech delivered a message of hope and excitement about the future of his city and of the country. A 34-year-old Muslim American immigrant, Mamdani has been the target of President Trump's ire, but that did not deter him. In fact, the Mayor-Elect had a warning for Trump: "To get to any of us, you will have to get through all of us."
