Volunteer for the Democratic Party's Presidential Primary on March 12

The NMI Democratic Party is looking for volunteers on Saipan, Tinian, and Rota to assist with next month's Presidential Primary. Volunteers are needed to assist with registration, ballot access, ballot tabulation, voter file registry, and other duties. On the ballot for the Democratic Party of the Northern Mariana Island's Presidential Primary, scheduled for March 5-12, are President Joseph R. Biden, Jr., Mr. Jason M. Palmer, Representative Dean Phillips (Minnesota), and Ms. Marianne Williamson.

Anyone interested in participating in the primary must be a U.S. citizen, a resident of the Northern Mariana Islands, and 18 years of age or eligible to vote on or before November 5, 2024. Democrats on Saipan, Tinian, and Rota will be able to visit designated polling sites, register to vote if they haven't already, register with the party, and cast votes for their preferred Democratic Presidential Candidate.

During the Presidential Primary, NMI Democrats will elect eight delegates to represent the CNMI at the 2024 Democratic National Convention in Chicago. The convention will nominate the Democratic Party candidates for President and Vice President of the United States of America. The final day of the NMI primaries on March 12 will be held on Saipan at the Pedro P. Tenorio Multi-Purpose Center in Susupe, with simultaneous sub-primaries on Tinian and Rota. Additional details are forthcoming.

Individuals interested in becoming delegates to the 2024 Democratic National Convention pledged to one of the Presidential candidates are encouraged to visit www.nmidems.org, download the Delegate Candidacy form, complete the form, and email it to NMI Democratic Party Chair Jonathan P. Cabrera at cabrerajpp@gmail.com. The deadline to file delegate candidacies is Monday, February 26, 2024.

Executive Director Nola Hix is hoping to see more of the CNMI's youth participate in the exciting first ever Presidential Primary next month: "The 2022 elections hosted the largest voter turnout in the CNMI's history with over 19,275 voters registered, and 14,750 voters who exercised their rights to vote. That was phenomenal, and we encourage NMC, and the public and private schools to continue to turnout that vote by encouraging students to participate. I encourage teachers to find incentives on getting their students to register to vote where they can, making it count by voting in upcoming elections, and it doesn't hurt to get involved by volunteering as well."
