CNMI Democrats Announce the Reelection Bids of Democratic Incumbents

The Democratic Party of the Northern Mariana Islands is pleased to announce that Representative Denita Kaipat Yangetmai of Precinct 3, Representative Vicente Castro Camacho of Precinct 3, and Representative Diego Vincent Fejeran Camacho of Precinct 1 will be seeking reelection in November so that they might continue serving the people of their respective precincts in the CNMI House of Representatives.
